Attached you will find the order form for the mum fundraiser. Please print for your skater and sell...sell...sell!

Please read this entire letter, as the details of this sale are a little different than in past years!!

THERE WILL BE TWO OPTIONS FOR PICKUP DAYS THIS YEAR! YOU MUST LET ME KNOW WHICH DAY YOU WOULD LIKE TO COLLECT YOUR ORDER. (Yes, you can collect orders both weeks.) This allows us to get some people their orders quicker, while also allowing a longer selling time.

Pickup days: Saturday, September 4th.
 Saturday, September 11th

The Potted Mums Fundraiser will begin today, August 23, and will go through Tuesday, September 7, 2010.

Please turn in all final orders and money to me (or leave in the OSC mailbox at Goggin) NO LATER THAN TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 7th, for pickup on the 11th.

If you would like to take advantage of the early pick-up date, you must get your order and money to me by Thursday September 2nd, and let me know that you would like to pick up your order On September 4th.

The skaters will be picking up their mums Saturday, September 11, between 10-12 am at Butterfield Farms. Butterfield is located east of Oxford on Rt. 73.

These mums are Amish grown mums that are acquired and sold through Butterfield Farms. They are *big gorgeous mums!* Much nicer than the ones people will find at places such as Wal-Mart and even many other greenhouses!

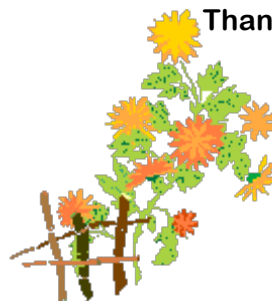
The mums are sold in 8" pots (but are about 24" in diameter) and are available in Deep Red, Lavender/Purple, Yellow, Bronze, and White!! They are not guaranteed to be hardy, but most often do come back if planted before fully bloomed. The price of the mums will be \$6.50 each this year. The skaters will earn \$2.50* per mum applied directly to their Crystal Credits! Butterfield Farms is being wonderful to us again this year and we are making an incredible profit!

(*As with all fundraisers, 10% of Skater profit will go to the club.)

So that Butterfield can have the mums ready for us, and be able to accommodate our color choices, we need to give them a weekly “color count” of our orders. Therefore, you will need to email me, angelaerfmanmeyers@gmail.com **each Friday** (8/27, 9/3) with your new color totals of the week. (ex. If you sell 50 white the first week and 20 white the following week, only report the additional 20 the second week, not the full total of 70. Drawing a line on the form under the orders you have already reported may help to keep it straight.) You can also call me at 765.265.0688 with your weekly color counts. Color choices cannot be guaranteed, especially if we don’t get weekly counts to Butterfield.

Also, each team **MUST** provide 2 volunteers to sort the mums on Friday evening the 10th at Butterfield Farm. I may also need people who are picking up a week early to come help pull their order. Team moms, I would really appreciate your help in making sure that each team is represented. The time will be finalized closer to that date. One person from each team must be there on Sat. morning of pickup to help get the right girls with the right mums! Please email Angie if you will be able to help sort on Friday or Saturday! Last year this process went very quickly and very smoothly thanks to the helpers!!
