### Skate Sale

This year our annual Skate Sale takes place Saturday, October 24. This is a great opportunity of all of us buy, sell, or exchange tights, dresses, and skates and other skating paraphernalia. Angela Meyers has agreed to organize and run the sale, but she needs help to pull it off. We need 3 or 4 volunteers to help with the shop. We should have 2 people for the first shift (8-10:30 am) and another 2 for the second shift (10:30 am-1 pm). ### Holiday Show

Believe it or not, but we are already working on putting this year's OSC Holiday Show together. ## Hockey Game Clean Up

OSC has committed to help Goggin with the clean-up after hockey games on the following dates: 10/3, 10/10, 11/14, 12/12, 01/10, and 02/20. The 01/10 game is on a Sunday, all others are Saturday games. We will run these as team-fundraisers to defray travel costs. Both the Intermediate and Open Juvenile teams will do two of the games, the Preliminary team will do one game, and the Beginner 1 and Beginner 3 teams will do one game together. Details will be coming up at a later time.

## Football Concession

OSC has been offered to work the football game concession at Yager Stadium for 5 games: Saturdays 10/3, 10/24, and 10/31; Thursday 11/12; Wednesday 11/18. While the Saturday games are mid-day, the Wednesday and Thursday games are in the evening. If we take this opportunity we have to commit to 5 dates plus 2 additional dates in case Miami makes the playoffs. We must have 10 people to work each date. We would be working 2 trailers. They provide hats and ID tags for each worker. We would earn 15% of the total sales, and it would be distributed to individual Club members as Crystal Credits. If we don't have all 10 show, or are late, we only get 13% and they probably won't ask us back again. Payment is at the end of the football season.

OSC has not committed to do this, as we are not sure we will have enough people who are able or willing to commit to these games.
